1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India is for initiating action against the respondent for violating order, Annexure P/1 dated 13.11.2019 in CWP No.32649 of 2019.
3. Learned counsel contends that vide order dated 13.11.2019, CWP No.32649 of 2019 was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide representations dated 30.08.2019 and 03.09.2019 respectively in accordance with law within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order but till date, needful has not been done, therefore, the respondent is liable to be proceeded against under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for non-compliance with order dated 13.11.2019 in CWP No.32649 of 2019.
4. Mr. Vivek Chauhan, Addl. A.G., Haryana, on instructions from the respondent, has filed a copy of order dated 11.11.2020, passed by the

respondent, rejecting representations dated 30.08.2019 and 03.09.2019. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who on perusal of the same states that in the circumstances he does not press the Contempt Petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to take action qua rejection of his representations, in accordance with law.

- 6. The same is not opposed to by learned State Counsel.
- 7. Accordingly, in the light of the position as noted above as also in view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the Contempt Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for.
