Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.22 dated 11.04.2019 under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Morinda, District Rupnagar. He apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police in the above said FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 06.10.2020 whereby while issuing notice of motion to the respondent-State, the interim protection was extended to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that in deference to the said order, the petitioner submitted himself before the Police and joined the investigation. According to him, the petitioner cooperated with the Police Authorities during the investigation and furnished requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel does not dispute this fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Inderjeet Singh, further states that he is not required for custodial

interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 06.10.2020 is made absolute.
