GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to take action by way of lodging a FIR against respondents No.4 to 12 who are alleged to have caused injuries to the petitioner, Raju and Munish Kumar.

Learned counsel in order to substantiate his case has referred to photographs annexed with the petition as Annexure P-1 and also the MLRs of petitioner-Munna Rai, Raju and Munish Kumar (Annexures P-2 to P-4 respectively). It has been submitted that although the petitioner also

submitted a representation dated 16.6.2020 (Annexure P-5) to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, but no action has been taken thereupon.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and while refraining from making any expression as regards the averments made in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar (respondent No.2) to look into the matter and to dispose off the representation dated 16.6.2020 (Annexure P-5) in accordance with law. In case the allegations levelled therein are found to be well founded, then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest.

A copy of representation Annexure P-5 and copy of this order be sent to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar (respondent No.2), so as to enable him to do the needful at the earliest.
