The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has filed the present fifth (5th) petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.41 dated 10.05.2017 registered under Sections 21 and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Khalra, District Tarn Taran.

Status report by way of affidavit of Rajbir Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Valtaha, Camp at Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran has been filed on behalf of respondent-State in the registry which is taken on record.

Learned State Counsel has submitted that the prosecution evidence has been concluded in the case.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner does not want to continue with the
