The matter has been taken up through video conferencing in the light of COVID-19 pandemic.

The present petition has been filed by the petitioner thereby seeking direction to respondent no.1 to further direct respondent nos. 2 to 5 to register FIR against respondent nos. 6 to 9 under Sections 323, 324, 427 and 452 read with Section 34 IPC.

Notice of motion.

Mr. P.S. Walia, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

The grievance of the petitioner is that her son namely Princejeet Singh and daughter of respondent No.5 namely Harjeet Kaur had solemnized marriage. They have also filed a petition bearing CWP No. 21306 of 2019 for protection, which has been disposed of on 16.09.2019 with a direction to SHO Jandiala District Amritsar to take necessary action in case need arises. After this marriage, the petitioner alongwith her family members started living with

their relatives but when on 30.08.2020, when the petitioner and her family

members returned to their house at village Nawa Pind, respondent nos. 6 to 9 had entered into the house of the petitioner illegally and gave beatings to the petitioner and her children. Despite this act, having committed by the respondents, no action is being taken by the police authorities. Even representation dated 26.08.2020 had been given to SHO. P.S. Nawa Pind, District Amritsar. Another representation dated 31.08.2020 had been given to the Commissioner, District Amritsar, copy whereof is Annexure P-3 as well as another representation dated 01.09.2020 given to Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Amritsar, copy whereof is Annexure P-4. Despite these representations, no action has been taken on the same.

However, learned State counsel has assured that the aforesaid representations shall be decided in accordance with law.

In view of the assertions so made and the assurance given by learned State counsel, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent nos. 2,3 and 4 to look into the matter and also to consider the representations aforesaid, which are Annexures P-2 to P-4 respectively and to redress the grievance of the petitioner in view of the contents of the representations, in accordance with law.

However, these observations are circumscribed only for the purposes of disposal of the present petition and shall not be construed as expression on merits and shall also have no effect upon the civil or criminal proceedings, pending between the parties concerned.
