The petitioner is seeking extension in time for permission to travel abroad.

In terms of the order dated 21.07.2020 (Annexure P-5), the application of the petitioner to go abroad was allowed by the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar, subject to certain conditions as enumerated in the order. The petitioner is now seeking extension of permission alleging that there are restricted flights due of Covid-19 Pandemic. In the order dated 21.07.2020, it was specifically mentioned that the petitioner will not seek extension of time and would surrender in the Court on or before 16.09.2020.

It has been conceded that no request for extension in time has been submitted before the learned trial Court.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that the present petition may be disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the trial Court for extension of time to return back.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in the event any such application seeking extension of permission to stay abroad is moved by the petitioner before the learned trial Court, the same may be considered in accordance with law.
