The petitioner in CWP-28551 of 2019 on the file of learned Single Judge of this Court has come up in this intra Court appeal impugning order dated 25.08.2020.

Heard the learned counsel for the appellant and perused the order impugned.

It is seen that the appellant herein who was appointed as special police officer on contractual basis is found to have suppressed certain facts from the department while getting appointment on contractual basis where it is seen that he was involved in an FIR bearing No. 192 dated 23.02.2016 registered under Section 147, 148, 341, 186, 353 and 506 IPC, at police station Sadar Gurgaon. However, in the writ petition an attempt is made by him to contend that he is not Bholu son of Raj Singh, who is accused in the said FIR and he is wrongly understood as such. However, when the matter was taken up for consideration it is also noticed that while in service on

contractual basis he was involved in another crime registered bearing FIR No. 81 dated 12.05.2019 for the offence punishable under Section 171C, 171F, 188 of IPC at Police Station Rojka Meo for interfering with election process. With such antecedents the finding of the learned Single Judge in dismissing his writ petition is just and proper. It is further seen that the learned Single Judge even while dismissing the writ petition was considerate in holding that the petitioner has an option to avail the alternate remedy of filing a civil suit thereby clearly not shutting all the doors available to him.

In the aforesaid circumstance, we are of considered opinion that the order of learned Single Judge dated 25.08.2020 passed in CWP No. 28551 of 2019 does not call for interference of this Court in this intra court appeal and the same is dismissed.
