Petitioner Budh Singh, aged about 57 years has filed the instant civil writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India against the respondents seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the impugned action of the respondents, vide which the petitioner, a seasonal worker was removed from service on 01.09.2020 before completion of sessions from 01.05.2020 to 30.09.2020 of Malaria, in an arbitrary manner.

The petitioner is said to have submitted representation to the respondents before filing of the present writ petition without eliciting any response.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rajneesh Chadwal, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner

would be satisfied if the present petition is disposed of directing the respondents to consider the grievances of the petitioner within a fixed time frame well before 30.09.2020.

Learned State counsel states that the respondents would abide by any direction issued by this Court in that regard.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and in order to avoid unnecessary litigation between the parties, the present writ petition is disposed of, directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner and to take suitable action, if so warranted, within a period of 10 days from today. However, since the petition is not being decided on merits, it shall be open to the petitioner to seek his legal remedy including approaching this Court again, if he still feel aggrieved after disposal of his representation. The present writ petition along with annexures be taken as representation on behalf of the petitioner for the purpose of consideration by the respondents.
