The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.295 dated 15.07.2020, under Sections 379-A and 201 IPC, registered at Police Station City Jind, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR wherein it is mentioned that 02 persons on a bike had snatched the purse and mobile phone of the complainant. He also contends that the complainant has furnished an affidavit that the petitioner is not the person who had snatched her mobile phone. The petitioner is in custody for over 02 months and is not involved in any other case.

Mr. Rakesh Kumar Chaudhary, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and states that the complainant has indeed filed an affidavit wherein it is mentioned that the petitioner is not one of those boys, who had snatched the belongings of the complainant.

Learned State counsel states that the challan has been filed but charges are yet to be framed.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 02 months, he is not involved in any other case, Covid 19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
