The petitioner is one of the accused in FIR No.24 dated 15.02.2020 on the file of Police Station Division Nakodar Sadar, District Jalandhar, registered under Sections 323, 324, 148 and 149 IPC. By way of this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C, he seeks quashing of the FIR.

The petitioner states that the matter has already been compromised with the complainants, *vide* compromise deed dated 06.06.2020.

On the strength of the very same compromise deed, this Court passed an order on 10.09.2020 in CRM-M-26334-2020, filed by the other accused, quashing FIR No.24 dated 15.02.2020 on the file of Police Station Division Nakodar Sadar, Disdtrict Jalandhar and all proceedings relating thereto.

Be it noted that the quashing of the FIR in that case was not limited to the petitioners therein, the other three accused named in the FIR. When the FIR was quashed in its entirety, the question of proceeding against the present petitioner on the ground that he was not a party to the former case does not arise.

The petition is accordingly disposed of making it clear that the order passed in CRM-M-26334-2020 would have the effect of quashing the subject FIR in its entirety against all the named accused therein, apart from quashing all other proceedings relating thereto.
