Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking directions to the respondents to pay the unpaid D.A. arrears increased from time to time along with 9% interest.

At the outset, learned Counsel for the petitioners has stated that his clients would be satisfied in case the Legal Notice dated 07.07.2020 (P-5) is decided by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

Prayer seems to be justified.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Gagandeep Singh Virk, Advocate for Mr. Ajaypal Singh, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that he has no objection in case the innocuous prayer of the petitioners is accepted.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the Legal Notice dated 07.07.2020 (P-5) in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within a period of 02 (two) months from today.

Needless to say that in case the petitioners are found entitled, the benefit be released forthwith.
