The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of the restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Amarjit Kaur, stated to be aged 47 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of contempt for not complying with the judgment dated 13.02.2020, passed by this Court in CWP-3931-2020 (Annexure P-1).

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Ravinder Budhwar, Additional AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has instructions from the Department to state that in compliance to the order dated 13.02.2020, passed by this Court in CWP-3931-2020, the petitioner has been considered and promoted as TGT (Punjabi) w.e.f. 30.07.2018, vide

order dated 18.06.2020, passed by the Additional Director Administration, Directorate Elementary Education, Panchkula (Haryana).

In view of the above, this Court finds that substantial compliance of the order of this Court, has been done by the respondents.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that inspite of this order having been passed on 18.06.2020, till date, the petitioner has not been given salary of the promoted post.

In view of the above, the respondents are directed to ensure the compliance i.e. the consequential relief of salary of promoted post, within one month from today.

Contempt petition disposed of accordingly.
