Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.29 dated 17.03.2020 for offences punishable under Sections 417,420 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Abohar, and for adding offence under Sections 307, 354, 354-B, 376 and 493 IPC. Further prayer has been made to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.3 to 6 and for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to decide the complaint/representation dated 31.07.2020 (Annexure P/2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation on 31.07.2020 to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/2, but still no action has been taken.

At the asking of Court, Mr. A.A. Pathak, Additional Advocate

General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2.

Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka, to look into and decide representation dated 31.07.2020 (Annexure P/2) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
