The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case
bearing FIR No.16 dated 18.03.2020 registered under Sections
380, 447, 448, 511, 34 IPC at Police Station City Ahmedgarh,
District Sangrur.

Petitioner is Jethani of the complainant. A civil
litigation is pending between the parties. The allegations are

that the petitioner along with her husband has demolished the wall and stole bricks of the complainant. Petitioner is 64 years of age and is a woman. There was replacement of her knees.

Notice of motion was issued on 22.09.2020 along with interim direction.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kewal Singh admitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer and he further stated that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of above, order dated 22.09.2020 is made absolute. However, petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so by the Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
