This is the third petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking bail pending trial in case FIR No.34 dated 05.02.2019 registered under Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act and Sections 307, 34 IPC (193, 195, 365,120-B IPC added later on) at Police Station Hasanpur, District Palwal.

A perusal of the record shows that earlier the first petition was dismissed on merits, as well as, keeping in view the fact that the complainant had already disclosed that he was put under extreme pressure on behalf of the petitioner to resile from his statement. It was specifically observed that the petitioner could not be released on bail because he was likely to pressurise the complainant not to depose against him.

Thereafter, the petitioner filed second petition for the same purpose. However, when this Court was not inclined to interfere, counsel for the petitioner had sought permission to withdraw that petition. Accordingly, the second petition filed by the petitioner was dismissed as withdrawn.

Now the third petition has been filed taking the same grounds on merits of the case. However, since this Court has already dismissed the bail application filed by the petitioner on merits, coupled with the apprehension of the complainant qua pressure not to depose against the petitioner, therefore, this Court does not find any ground to interfere and to grant bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
