The present petition has been filed by the petitioner *inter alia* seeking a mandamus directing the respondent No.3 to lawfully offer actual physical possession of residential plot bearing No.727, measuring 10 marlas in Sector 30, Urban estate, Pinjore, District Panchkula.

When this matter came up for consideration before this Court, learned counsel Mr. Deepak Sabharwal, appearing for respondent-HSVP, stated that if the present writ petition is withdrawn with liberty to approach the respondents by filing an application seeking condonation of delay, if any, the same will be considered favourably and the money due will be taken to regularize the plot. At this juncture, learned counsel for the petitioner apprehends that the interest part may also arise for consideration.

In any event, we are of the opinion that it is too far-fetched, at a time, when there is an assurance by counsel for the HSVP for the petitioner to approach the HSVP by filing an application seeking condonation of delay, if any. It is appropriate, according to us, for the

petitioner to withdraw the present writ petition and file an application before the HSVP which shall be considered within 15 days as assured by counsel for the respondents, Mr. Sabharwal.

With the aforesaid observations, this writ petition is disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty aforementioned.
