1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Learned counsel contends that despite the order of this Court dated 19.02.2020, in CWP No.4546 of 2020, directing the respondent to consider and decide the appeal filed by the petitioner dated 25.11.2019, in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter, as expeditiously as possible, the same has not been decided till date.
3. Notice to the respondent to show cause as to why proceedings under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 be not initiated against him for willful disobedience of the order of this Court, Annexure P/1, dated 19.02.2020.
4. Mr. Vivek Chauhan, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and on the basis of instructions received from the Law Officer O/o the Chief Information Commissioner, Haryana,

states that the appeal has been decided in compliance of the order of this Court dated 19.02.2020 in CWP No.4546 of 2020 and that order on the appeal would be communicated to the petitioner shortly.

5. The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner.
6. In view of the position as noted above, the Contempt Petition is disposed of as not calling for any further orders, except, for directing that the order deciding the appeal be communicated to the petitioner within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
