The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from being falsely implicated in case by respondent No.4 at the behest of respondent No.5 and not to harass the petitioner.

A bare perusal of the petition shows that the petitioner has filed the present petition with oblique motive to block the legal remedies of the complainant, in favour of whom the petitioner is alleged to have executed agreement to sell and the necessary sale deed is not being executed by the petitioner. Except this bald assertion that the petitioner has not executed the said agreement, there is nothing on record to even remotely suggest any threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner. So far as the grievance of the petitioner qua agreement to sell is concerned, the

petitioner is always at liberty to seek declaration qua the aspects which he is claiming, from the civil court.

In view of the above, finding no merits in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
