1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating action against the respondent for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order Annexure P/1 dated 16.01.2020, in CRM-M-1798-2020, in case titled as Harbhajan Singh alias Bikka vs. State of Punjab and others.
3. Learned counsel contends that vide order Annexure P/1 dated 16.01.2020, CRM-M-1798-2020, was disposed of by directing the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, to decide representation dated 15.11.2019, as expeditiously as possible, and that in the reply filed on behalf of the respondent, it has been mentioned that representation dated 15.11.2019, has been decided and DDR No.23 dated 09.09.2020, registered and in view

thereof, the petitioner does not press the Contempt Petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. The same is not opposed to by learned DAG, Punjab.
5. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the Contempt Petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
