1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.94 dated 19.07.2020, registered under Sections 452, 323, 34 of IPC, 1860 at Police Station Sadar Jalalabad, District Fazilka.
