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**B.S. Walia, J. (VC)**

1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present petition, with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court and to move an application for regular bail, with directions being issued to the learned trial Court to consider and decide the application for regular bail expeditiously.
3. Mr. Saurav Khurana, learned DAG, Punjab, who is present, does not oppose the same.

In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is ***dismissed as withdrawn***, with the liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court and in the eventuality of a petition for regular bail being moved by the petitioner, the learned trial Court is directed to consider and decide the same, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.
