This is a petition that has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No. 99 dated 28.04.2020 under Sections 323, 324, 188, 326, 506, 34 IPC (offence under Section 326 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Division No. 5, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter-alia would contend that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the said FIR .

Notice of motion.

Ms. Rashmi Attri, AAG, Punjab appearing through the medium of video conferencing accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. She opposes the contention raised by learned counsel for the petitioner and submits that the main allegation of having attacked the complainant is upon the petitioner, who inflicted grievous injuries upon the complainant, pursuant to which Section 326 IPC has been added to the said FIR.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner does not

press the petition, while further submitting that the petitioner would surrender before the trial Court and join the proceedings as per law.

Dismissed, being not pressed.

However, in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of one week and moves application for regular bail, his application for bail shall be considered in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible.
