Due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19, the instant case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The provisions of the Bonded Labour System (Abolition) Act, 1976 provides remedy to the petitioner to move the appropriate authority (Vigilance Committee) of the district. However, counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had earlier moved the District Magistrate of Ludhiana and has sought to place reliance on Annexure P-1, however the same is wholly unsubstantiated on records.

In the light of this stand, the petitioner is directed to move

afresh his representation as the one placed on record as Annexure P-1 is not supported by any material which could establish that service of this notice was duly made on the authorities. Upon the petitioner moving the Vigilance Committee through the District Magistrate, Ludhiana, directions are issued to the later to dispose off the same without loss of time in accordance with law, in view of the provisions of aforesaid Act.

The present petition stands disposed off accordingly.
