All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

By this petition, filed under the provisions of Section 482 of the Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks quashing of FIR no.048, dated 26.05.2020, registered at Police Station Raipur Rani, District Panchkula, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 363, 366A, 120-B of the IPC and Section 4 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, as also subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of a compromise stated to have been reached between the petitioner and respondent no.2. A copy of the compromise deed has been annexed as Annexure P-2 with the petition.

Pursuant to the order dated 16.10.2020, the report of the Chief

Judicial Magistrate, Panchkula, dated 10.11.2020, has been received, stating therein that the prosecutrix made a statement before that court (upon her having been brought under escort of a lady constable), that she did not know that her father had fixed her marriage with the petitioner and further she did not wish to get married as per the wishes to her father and would marry after 2-3 years, if she found somebody caring for her.

The age of the prosecutrix as recorded in her statement before the CJM, Panchkula, is shown to be 18 years.

The aforesaid being told to learned counsel for the petitioner, he seeks to withdraw the petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

Obviously, no comment is made at all on the merits of the case by this court.
