This criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 5 to provide immediate adequate security and police protection at the premises of Gurdawara Shri Kalgidhar Singh Sabha, Phase-IV, SAS Nagar to safeguard the life of the sangat/visitors and to take immediate action against respondent Nos.6 to 40 on the complaints/representations dated 10.08.2020 (Annexure P-11), 15.08.2020 (Annexure P-12) and 17.08.2020 (Annexure P-13) moved by petitioner No.2.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioners that a civil suit No.340 of 2020 already stands filed by the petitioners, wherein a restraint order has already been passed against the defendants. It is pointed out that for violation of the injunction order, an application under Order 39, Rule 2-A C.P.C. for initiating contempt proceedings is also pending.

Apart from it, a complaint under Section 156 (3) Code of Criminal Procedure also stands filed for causing injuries to the Sewadar of the Gurdawara Shri Kalgidhar Singh Sabha (Regd.).

When confronted with the maintainability of the petition, in the light of the alternative remedy as earlier adopted by the petitioners, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press this petition and wishes to avail the same in accordance with law.

The prayer is accepted.

The petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
