The petitioner was employed on contractual basis as a Security Officer with respondent no.2-University. He worked from 2013 to 23.8.2020. Thereafter, he has not been continued in the employment even on contractual basis.

The petitioner has filed this writ petition claiming a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent no.2-University, not to replace him with another to be appointed contractual employee.

On notice, the University has filed reply. Sh. Sajjan Singh, Advocate has appeared for the University and states that efforts are being made to fill up the post on regular basis. He submits that a recruitment notice in this regard has already been issued. He further

submits that the University does not intend to appoint anyone on contractual basis against the post held by the petitioner. He further submits that the work and conduct of the petitioner was also not above board.

Keeping in view the aforesaid stand of the University, the writ petition has become infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.
