Prayer in this criminal writ petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents, who are openly threatening the petitioners to eliminate them and trying to involve them in false criminal case in connivance of the local police and to decide the representation dated 17.08.2020 filed by the petitioners.

It is stated in the petition that the petitioner No.1 was married to respondent No.4 – Ribika and due to some matrimonial dispute, she has left the company of petitioner No.1. It is further stated that the petitioner No.1 and respondent No.4 have a male child namely Yosaph. A perusal of the petition further show that respondent No.4 – Ribika has left the home on 12.05.2020 and she is now threatening to take legal action against the petitioners and the petitioners are facing threat to their life and liberty.

After hearing the counsel for the petitioners and going

through the contents of the petitions, it is apparent that there is a matrimonial dispute between the petitioner No.1 and respondent No.4 and for that the petitioner No.1 has an efficacious remedy to approach the Family Court. It appears that the petitioners are apprehending that respondent No.4 may institute a criminal complaint either under the Indian Penal Code or under the Domestic Violence Act and thus, in that eventuality, the remedies lies elsewhere.

In view of the above, I find no ground to entertain this petition and accordingly, the same is dismissed.
