The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Through this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 & 3 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of respondents No.5 to 9 and for taking strict legal action/registration of FIR against them.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the purpose would be achieved if respondent No.3 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga is directed to look into representation dated 20.05.2020 (Annexure P-4) moved by the petitioner, in a time-bound manner.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, but without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 – Senior

Superintendent of Police, Moga, to look into representation dated 20.5.2020 of the petitioner (Annexure P-4) and decide the same after hearing the petitioner by passing a speaking order within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
