The case has been taken up for hearing through
video-conferencing.

Petitioners have preferred this petition for issuance of
a writ, order or direction for protecting their lives and personal
liberties from being invaded by the private respondents.

Petitioners have alleged that they have solemnized
the marriage against the wishes of their parents and relatives.
They feel reasonable apprehension and threat perception at the
hands of the private respondents and pray that their
personal/civil rights be not violated by them.

Petitioners are major and they have already approached the respondent No.2 by way of representation dated 10.09.2020 which is statedly pending.

Notice of motion was issued on 17.09.2020.

In view of prayer made by the petitioners, it would be appropriate to direct respondent No.2 to decide the pending representation filed by the petitioners (if any) in accordance with law.

Respondent No.2 would be at liberty to devise his/her own ways and means to ascertain truth in the allegation of the petitioners. In case, the threat perception is found to be genuine, then necessary action be taken in accordance with law.
