The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.114 dated 14.08.2020 under Sections 326, 323, 324, 506, 427, 452, 354, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on after 18 days) registered at Police Station Raja Sansi, District Amritsar, Punjab.

In response to order dated 25.09.2020 passed by this Court, learned State counsel submits that the police has already taken into possession the torn shirts of Ramandeep Kaur and Amandeep Kaur.

As per allegations, the petitioner torn the shirt of younger daughter-in-law of the complainant namely Ramandeep Kaur. When Charanjit Singh (devar) of the complainant came forward to save Ramandeep Kaur, then the petitioner gave dattar blow on the right hand wrist of Charanjit Singh. Some unknown person gave a dang blow on the waist of Charanjit Singh. Then Kulwinder Kaur (wife of the petitioner) gave iron rod blow on the left side of head of Charanjit Singh. On hearing noise, elder daughter-in-law of the complainant came forward to save him. Then Gurmeet Singh @ Gugu gave dattar blow to the complainant. The complainant in order to save himself raised his left hand and the blow ultimately hit on the left arm. In the meanwhile, petitioner torn the shirt of elder daughter-in-law of the complainant namely Amandeep Kaur.

Allegations against the petitioner are serious in nature.

No ground is made out to grant indulgence in favour of the petitioner.

This petition is accordingly, dismissed.
