The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.210 dated 17.08.2019 under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 448, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga on parity with co-accused namely Jasdeep Singh @ Deep and Gurpreet Singh who have been enlarged on regular bail on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that both the parties have amicably resolved their differences and the offence is triable by the Magistrate.

At the time of granting regular bail to the co-accused namely Jasdeep Singh @ Deep and Gurpreet Singh on 01.09.2020, Mr. Vishwajit Singh Rishi, Advocate/complainant- in person appeared before this Court and stated that the parties have resolved their differences to the satisfaction of complainant party. He showed his no objection for grant of regular bail to the co-accused.

Owing to the situation and without meaning anything on the merits of the case, co-accused namely Jasdeep Singh @ Deep and Gurpreet Singh were granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 01.09.2020.

Learned State counsel admits the factum of granting bail to the aforesaid accused on the basis of compromise vide order dated 01.09.2020.

In view of aforesaid factual position and keeping in view the situation arising out of pandemic COVID-19, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail on parity with co-accused namely Jasdeep Singh @ Deep and Gurpreet Singh.

In view of above, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/concerned Duty Magistrate.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an opinion on the merits of the case.
