The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside of the order dated 03.09.2020 passed by the Financial Commissioner (Revenue) Punjab, Chandigarh.

An appeal filed by the respondent-Sukhchain Singh is pending before the Commissioner, Ferozepur Division, Ferozepur. The petitioner filed an application before the Financial Commissioner (Revenue) Punjab, Chandigarh for transferring the pending appeal from the Court of Commissioner, Ferozepur Division, Ferozepur, which has been dismissed by a detailed order on 03.09.2020.

This Court has heard learned counsel for the parties at some length.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the Commissioner has not given his counsel a fair opportunity to put forth his arguments. He submits that the order is yet to be pronounced by the Commissioner, Ferozepur Division, Ferozepur.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court is of the opinion that ends of justice would be met if the present petition is disposed of with a direction that the petitioner as well as respondent would be permitted to file their written submissions within a period of one week from today and thereafter, the Commissioner, would proceed to decide the same after taking into consideration the written submissions, if any filed.

With these observations, the revision petition is disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are disposed of, in view of the aforesaid order.
