The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.130 dated 27.04.2020 registered under Section 22-61-85 of the Narcotics Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and Section 51 (b) of Disaster Management Act, 2005 at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka.

Pursuant to order dated 17.09.2020 passed by this court, the counsel for the State has filed the status report by way of affidavit of Jasbir Singh, DSP, Sub Division, Fazilka, which is taken on record. It is categorically stated in the status report that the petitioner, as well as, some police officials were injured in accident when the police were

trying to arrest the petitioner. The police officials, as well as, the petitioner, both were taken to the hospital. However, a heavy quantity of 2000 tablets containing Tramadol were recovered from the car of the petitioner.

Since the quantity is so heavy and the investigation is at the initial stage, therefore, this court does not find this to be a fit case to exercise its powers under Section 438 Cr.P.C. so as to protect the petitioner against his arrest.

Dismissed.
