The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent No.4 to consider the representation dated 06.07.2020 (Annexure P-6) of the petitioners for the protection of their life and to restrain the private respondents from making interference in the management and work of Management Committee of Gurdawara Sahib Chhotta Ghallughara, Village Gorahoor, Tehsil Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

A bare perusal of the petition shows that the present petition has been filed with an oblique motive and to settle some dispute regarding management of Gurudawara. The facts pleaded by the petitioners point to a purely civil dispute, for which the petitioners can very well avail their remedies before the Civil Court of law.

Accordingly, finding no merits in the petition, the same is dismissed.
