Challenge in the present writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227
of the Constitution of India is to the transfer order dated 09.02.2020 (Annexure
P-1).

A perusal of the writ petition would go on to show that there are
no details of the earlier places of postings of the petitioner. Counsel has relied
upon photocopy of the service book to show the places of postings. Such a
methodology is not appreciated in any manner as it is imperative for the
petitioner to plead specifically by way of affidavit where he had remained
posted and for what periods, to make out a case in his favour. The respondents
have to be given a chance, as such, to reply to the pleadings.

Faced with this situation, counsel does not press the present writ
petition and prays for liberty to withdraw the same, to file a fresh one, on the
same cause of action, with better particulars.

Ordered accordingly.
