In compliance of order dated 27.01.2020, learned counsel for the petitioners has produced receipts of ₹20,000/-. The same are taken on record.

Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.51 dated 30.05.2018, registered under Sections 447, 511, 427, 336, 148, 149 IPC and 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-3) arrived at between the parties.

Pursuant to order dated 31.05.2019 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court on 12.04.2019 to get their

statements recorded.

Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Gurdaspur, has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.354 dated 15.06.2019.

According to the above report, compromise entered into between the parties is bona fide, genuine and without any pressure or coercion.

Therefore, in view of above and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in between the parties, FIR No.51 dated 30.05.2018, registered under Sections 447, 511, 427, 336, 148, 149 IPC and 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed.

Disposed of accordingly.

Registry shall verify the deposit of costs by the petitioners with the quarters concerned.
