The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 89 dated 14.04.2020 registered at Police Station Nissing, District Karnal, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 326 IPC and 3(2)(VA) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody for more than 05 months. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as even charges have not been framed. There is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner and thus, he may be granted regular bail.

Custody certificate dated 08.10.2020 has been presented in Court. The same is taken on record. According to this certificate, the

petitioner has undergone actual custody of 05 months and 22 days and there is no other criminal case pending against him.

Learned State counsel concedes that charges have not yet been framed.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has undergone more than 05 months of custody and the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
