The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and to save them from the illegal as well as unnecessary harassment in the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

The facts of this case shows that petitioner No.2 is already married and having four children. Even his first wife is still alive. Despite that, the petitioner No.2 has eloped with petitioner No.1. The entire conduct on the part of the petitioners is reflective of significant bravery and shows that they are not bothered about any social pressures or social restrictions. As a corollary to this, they would not feel threatened in any ordinary course. Still further, even as per the assertion of the petitioners, the brother of petitioner No.1 has committed suicide after she had run away with petitioner No.2. This also shows that the petitioners have no threat from the family of petitioner No.1; rather; it is otherwise. So far as the record of the case is

concerned, there is nothing on record to show that there is any specific threat to the life and liberty of petitioners; as such. Hence, this Court does not find any ground to interfere and to pass any directions to the Police authorities.

Dismissed.
