The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct respondent No.1 to send the petition Annexure P-4 to the Principal Civil Court of District Court Jhajjar in view of Section 3-H(4) of the National Highway Act, 1956 as the partition proceedings are pending before the Financial Commissioner in ROR No.72 of 2016.

The counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if the concerned District Revenue Officer (DRO) takes decision on their application, which is attached with the present petition as Annexure P-4.

The counsel for the State has submitted that pursuant to the previous order, he has sought the instructions from the concerned DRO. It is further submitted that the concerned DRO shall take a decision on the application (Annexure P-4) moved by the petitioners, within a period of four weeks.

Accordingly the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to take decision on the application (Annexure P-4) of the petitioners, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
