Challenge in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is to the letter dated 03.09.2020 (Annexure P-2) issued by the Returning Officer of respondent No.3, whereby elections were to be held on 19.09.2020.

Counsel for the State has placed on record the letter dated 11.09.2020 written by the Returning Officer to the District Registrar, Firms and Societies, Panchkula, whereby the elections which were stated to be held on 19.09.2020 have been postponed.

In such circumstances, it is apparent that no cause of action has arisen for the petitioner to have filed the writ petition on 11.09.2020, since the election itself had been postponed by the Returning Officer.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
