Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and while refraining from making any expression as regards the averments made in the petition, the same is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police Amritsar (Rural), Amritsar to ensure that the matters pertaining to FIR No.75 dated 8.6.2020 under Section 420 IPC & Section 7 of the Essential Commodities, Act; and FIR No.128 dated 13.8.2020 under Section 506 IPC and Sections 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s) of SC/ST Act registered at Police Station Mehta, District Amritsar are got investigated fairly in accordance with law. As regards the apprehension of the petitioner regarding threat to his life and liberty is concerned, it shall be open to the petitioner to move an appropriate application before No.4-Senior

Superintendent of Police Amritsar (Rural), Amritsar in this regard. In case, any such application is filed, respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police Amritsar (Rural), Amritsar shall examine the alleged threat perception and do the needful as warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case expeditiously.
