Matter has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Counsel for the parties are ad idem that under similar circumstances other candidates had approached this Court by way of filing CWP-14287-2020 and which had been disposed of on 11.09.2020 by passing the following order:

“Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking directions to the respondent to include the name of the petitioners in the list of candidates called for scrutiny of documents for selection to the post of Clerk under Category No.1 in pursuance of Advertisement No.5/2019 dated 20.06.2019.

At the outset, learned Counsel for the petitioners has stated that his clients would be satisfied in case their representations dated 08.09.2020 (P-8 & P-9) are decided in accordance with law.

Prayer seems to be justified.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Ravinder Singh Dhull, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and gives an assurance to this Court that representations dated 08.09.2020 (P-8 & P-9) of the petitioners would be considered in case they submit the original documents to the Commission today itself.

If that be so, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to the sole respondent to consider and decide the aforesaid representations today itself and in case petitioners are found qualified, they be considered for the post of Clerk under the Eligible Sports Person (ESP) Category.”

The instant petition as such is also disposed of in terms of order dated 11.09.2020 passed in CWP-14287-2020 with the only modification that the representation preferred by the petitioner be considered and disposed of within a period of 10 days from today.
