AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Having heard the counsel for the parties and on going through the latest medical certificate of the petitioner, it is apparent that the petitioner is suffering from Hepatitis B but as per the report he is being properly taken care of. Even advice of the Specialist is being taken and the said medication, as advised, is being provided to the petitioner. As and when required, it is admitted, that the petitioner is taken to the hospital as well as the Specialist for investigation and treatment.

In the light of the above, when proper care of the petitioner is being taken, this Court does not find any reason to accept the petition of the petitioner at this stage.

The petition, therefore, stands dismissed.

However, a direction is issued to the Superintendent, Central Jail, Ludhiana, to ensure that proper treatment is provided to the petitioner as per the medical advise.
