Petitioner seeks regular bail pending trial in FIR No.331 dated 17.12.2019, under Sections 307, 382, 341, 323, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot.

At the very outset learned State Counsel has very fairly submitted that co-accused Veer Singh alias Prince and against whom there were similar allegations has been granted benefit of bail in the light of order dated 04.08.2020 in CRM-M No. 14792 of 2020.

On the ground of parity itself and by adopting the reasoning furnished by the Co-ordinate Bench in order dated 04.08.2020 in CRM-M

No. 14792 of 2020 (Veer Singh alias Prince vs. State of Punjab), petitioner

is held entitled to benefit of bail.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Faridkot.
