The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 398 dated 26.07.2019, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 326, 427, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station City, District Yamuna Nagar.

The operative part of the order dated 21.09.2020, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was nominated in the FIR on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused Bhavuk @ Punjabi and there are no direct allegations against him. It is further submitted that three co-accused Sumit Dahiya has been granted the concession of regular bail by this Court vide order dated 08.01.2020 passed in CRM-M-54186-2019 and two more co-accused Bhavuk @ Punjabi and Gurmeet have been released on bail by the trial Court Learned State counsel has, however, opposed the prayer for bail on the ground that the victim has suffered number of injuries.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in

pursuance to the order dated 21.09.2020, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Rajiv Kumar, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 21.09.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
