

**Rajender Singh Vs. Harpal Singh and anr.**

Appellant has appeared in person. He has stated that he has not engaged any counsel and he himself wants to compromise this matter with the respondent-Insurance Company.

The matter has been discussed. Appellant submits that for the purpose of compromise only in Lok Adalat and to avoid further litigation, he would be satisfied if another sum of ₹60,000/- (₹ Sixty Thousand Only) over and above the amount already awarded by the MACT concerned is granted to him in full and final settlement of the claim in the present appeal and in that eventuality, he would give up his claim regarding interest on the enhanced amount from the date of filing of the petition before the MACT, which is 26.04.2004. Statement of the appellant has also been recorded separately to this effect.

Learned counsel and representatives of the respondent-Insurance Company have agreed to enhance ₹60,000/- more over and above the amount of compensation already awarded by the Tribunal.

Thus, as agreed, as per statements of the appellant, learned counsel and representatives of the respondent – Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹60,000/- (₹ Sixty Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in

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full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As requested by the appellant, the enhanced amount be deposited in his following Bank Account:-

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit the enhanced amount of ₹60,000/- in the above stated bank account of the appellant within a period of one month, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
