Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 283 dated 11.06.2020 registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 324, 325, 307, 427 and 506 IPC at Police Station City Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners have neither been named in the FIR, nor any role has been attributed to them. The names of the petitioners have cropped in the present case on the disclosure statement of co-accused Lakhanpal and rather the petitioners were not present at the spot.

He further states that co-accused Ramandeep and Jagsir Singh have already been granted regular bail by this Court, vide orders dated 14.08.2020 and 03.09.2020 respectively. The petitioners were arrested on 30.07.2020.

On the instructions from ASI Ravinder Kumar, learned State counsel points out that injured- Gurvinder Singh has specifically named the petitioners in his statement recorded under Section 161 Cr.P.C.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioners have been in custody since 30.07.2020 and two co-accused have already been granted regular bail. The trial will take time to conclude and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioners behind the bars.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
