The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner prays for issuance of appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the official respondents to release the payment of bills in pursuance of the work done by him pursuant to allotment of contract for labour work.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has relied upon the bills dated 10.07.2020 (Annexures P10 to P13) to contend that the petitioner has raised the bills only after completing the work assignment.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity of issuance of notice to the

respondents as no order prejudicial to the interest of anyone is being passed.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after going through the material produced by him on record, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this writ petition without meaning anything on merits of the case at this stage with a direction to the respondent(s) to look into the grievance of the petitioner and in case, it is found that the bills raised by the petitioner are in pursuance of the work done, then the respondent(s) shall ensure that the bills in question are duly processed at its level in accordance with law and payment be released to the petitioner at the earliest. It would be appreciated if the needful is done within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
