Due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19, the instant case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Iqbal Singh, has made statement that petitioners in compliance of order dated 16.09.2020 have joined the investigation and thus, no recovery is required to be made. Learned counsel appearing for the complainant tried to oppose the same. Being a case of version and cross-version, it is difficult at this stage to find as which of the party is aggressor.

In light of the statement made by the learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 16.09.2020 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioners will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioners shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
