Case has been heard through video conferencing on account of
COVID-19 Pandemic.

This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482
Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of order (Annexure P-4) whereby he has been
declared as proclaimed person in criminal case having FIR No.139 dated
6.10.2017 registered under Sections 323, 341, 148 and 149 IPC at Police
Station Sadar, Phagwara.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the
remaining accused were acquitted in the aforesaid criminal case on
18.2.2020 as the matter has been compromised between the parties. Learned
counsel for the petitioner has made request that in the alternative, the
petitioner be given liberty to approach the learned trial Court and in the
meantime, he be not arrested by the police.

All the offences are bailable. The co-accused have been
acquitted vide judgment dated (Annexure P-2) dated 18.2.2020.

In these circumstances, this petition is hereby disposed of with

liberty to the petitioner to approach the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate

within 10 days and to move regular bail application which is to be disposed of by the said Court on that very day in accordance with law. It is further ordered that till then, no coercive action be taken against the petitioner.
